Vergil in his youth was one of a group of writers full of poetic ambitions; Varius, Cinna, Varus, Tucca, Pollio, and Vergil's own bosom-friend Gallus, to mention no others, were all writers of verse; but the economy of the centuries has swept away every trace of the big...
