It was the 79Th largest market for U.S. exports in 2012, according to U.S. Department of Commerce statistics. The Lebanese Customs Authority reported that Lebanon s total imports in 2012 reached approximately \$21.3 billion, of which \$2.376 billion (constituting 11 percent of the total) came from the United States. In 2012, the United States ranked as Lebanon s number one trading partner ahead of Italy, China, France and Germany. According to Lebanese Customs statistics, major U.S. exports to Lebanon were mineral fuel and oil (\$1.498 billion), vehicles (\$218 million), machinery and electrical instruments (\$170 million), products of chemical industries (\$154 million), prepared foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco (\$71 million), and vegetable products (\$39 million). Real GDP growth is estimated to have slowed from seven percent in 2010 to 1.5 percent in 2011 and 2012, according to the IMF s April 2013 World Economic Outlook, with nominal GDP estimated at \$41.3 billion in 2012. The IMF forecasts that growth could reach two percent in 2013, with...
